Eligibility

Algonquin's Art on the Fox is open to all artists. All artwork must be original, designed and executed by the accepted artist. Work done by a production studio is not acceptable. No kits, imports, crafts, manufactured items, resale goods, or product line reps are allowed.

Setup

Booth space is 10' x 10'. Setup can start at 5:00pm Friday. Be prepared for uneven or slightly sloped ground. Tear down will not begin until the end of the show. Artists who setup late or shut down early will compromise their eligibility to participate in future shows. On-site security is provided 5pm Saturday to 8am Sunday.

Awards

Judging will take place at 10:00am on Saturday. Ribbons and monetary awards will be given out on Saturday evening at an artist reception, to which all participating artists are invited.

Sales and Taxes

All proceeds go to the artist. Each artist is responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax (7.75%) on all sales made during the show.

**The booth fee will be refunded to any applicant not accepted into the show. Should an artist choose not to exhibit after being accepted into the show, the booth fee will be refunded only if the artist submits a request in writing, prior to June 1st.
