• Village Manager Schloneger thanked the Department Heads for their efforts in shifting work to ensure continuity of operations. As the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation continues to rapidly evolve we are communicating, responding, and taking steps to continue to operate safely, reliably and efficiently.

President Schmitt provided an overview of the coronavirus (COVID-19) information provided by Governor Pritzker and his key staff.

Mike Kumbera

- Staff has been focused on community outreach regarding COVID-19 and keeping the public apprised of the Village's response and availability of online services.
- Our Finance operation has been established in a hybrid capacity with some staff working remotely. Our payroll, accounts payable, and utility billing systems are functioning properly.
- Our Recreation team is staying in contact with program registrants with upcoming classes. We are also shifting into online activities and programs to keep customers engaged and active during the pandemic.

#### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT: None

#### POLICE DEPARTMENT: Chief Bucci

- Thank you to Kevin Crook and the IT department for stepping up during this pandemic they have been working in overdrive to ensure that all departments and employees are set up with whatever they need, specifically for those who are working remotely.
- Multiple meetings have been held, both in person and phone conference, with local, state and federal organizations to ensure that we are implementing best practices and sharing advice. We have implemented some internal changes amongst some divisions within the PD, such as split shift/working remotely this is in an attempt to limit contact and be able to maintain the high level of police service.

#### PUBLIC WORKS: Robert Mitchard

• Stage 2 Wet Utilities (N. Harrison) – Contractor working on storm sewer in a few areas. Beginning to pull curbs that were damaged or removed during construction project. Also removing driveways and

sidewalks that were affected by construction of sewer and water services. Roadway to remain gravel until mid-April – early May when hot mix asphalt is available. Road will be rebuilt in total from Park Street north to end of project. Remainder of road will remain in patch until Streetscape and bike path project gets funded.

- Stage 3 Wet Utilities Coordinating Dry Utilities to get out of way of construction. Precon still on hold. Permit pending at IDOT for utility crossings of Rt 62 and should resolve within next two weeks based on meeting at IDOT HQ today.
- WWTP is progressing smoothly, second payout for construction related service to Trotter approved today.
- Terrace Hill minor storm sewer work progressing, working with IDNR and Army Corp to get approval for a bypass channel to Woods Creek so that the contractor can work on the main channel and bridge without having to bypass pump. Curb being pulled on Fairway View and Greenview currently in preparation for road work.
- Souwanas, Scott, and Schuett project and Main Street Roundabout and Bike Path have been submitted and accepted to McCouncil of Mayors STP Call for Projects. Will hear results of funding awards in October, if not earlier.

#### BONAFIDE EMERGENCY FINDINGS:

Moved by Sosine, seconded by Glogowski, to find that there is a bonafide emergency, pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/2.02(a), warranting this special meeting of the Village Board based on the following findings of fact:

- Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a potentially severe acute respiratory infection caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). The virus was first identified as the cause of an outbreak of pneumonia of unknown cause in Wuhan City, Hubei Province, China, in December 2019; and
- On March 9, 2020, Governor J.B. Pritzker declared all counties in the State of Illinois as a disaster area; and
- On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization characterized the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic; and
- On March 11, 2020, McHenry County Board Chair Jack D. Franks proclaimed that a disaster emergency exists for the County of McHenry; and
- Following these actions, President John C. Schmitt issued a Proclamation of Local Disaster Emergency for the Village of Algonquin early today, March 17, 2020; and
- Governor Pritzker issued Executive Order 2020-04 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 2), cancelling all public and private gatherings in the State of Illinois of 1,000 people or more to implement social distancing; Governor Pritzker issued Executive Orders 2020-05 and 2020-06 (COVID-19 Executive Order Nos. 3 and 4), closing all public and private schools through March 30, 2020; and Governor Pritzker issued Executive Order 2020-07 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 5) suspending service at bars and restaurants in the State of Illinois to the public through March 30, 2020 and limiting all public and private gatherings in the State of Illinois of 50 people or more to implement social distancing.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 2020-O-\_\_\_\_ AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021

WHEREAS, the Village of Algonquin, McHenry and Kane Counties, Illinois is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Algonquin, McHenry and Kane Counties, Illinois, has adopted 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.1 through 5/8-2-9.9 in lieu of passing an appropriation ordinance prior to the end of the first quarter of the fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.4 requires that the annual budget shall be adopted by the corporate authorities before the beginning of the fiscal year to which it applies; and

- **SECTION 1**: That the Village of Algonquin Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved.
- **SECTION 2**: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 3**: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **SECTION 4**: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.

Schmitt, President of the Village of Algonquin, and the Village Board do hereby proclaim that a local disaster emergency still exists in the Village of Algonquin due to ongoing Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) concerns in the Village of Algonquin and McHenry and Kane Counties. The purpose is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local or interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans, to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance thereunder, and to bring this to as quick of a conclusion as possible.

The Village of Algonquin's emergency operations plans are hereby activated for the best interest of the residents of the Village of Algonquin.

## CONTINUATION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN, ILLINOIS

On March 17, 2020, I, John C. Schmitt, the President of the Village of Algonquin declared a Local State of Emergency in the Village of Algonquin in response to the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) which was in effect until April 16, 2020.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of Village President by the Illinois Municipal Code in Section 5/11-1-6, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act in Section 3305/11, and the Municipal Code of the Village of Algonquin, in Chapter 8, Emergency Services and Disaster Agency, I, John C. Schmitt, the President of the Village of Algonquin, do hereby declare that a Local State of Emergency still exists as of this date, April 7, 2020, and shall continue until May 19, 2020.

I find that an emergency, as defined in Chapter 8, Emergency Services and Disaster Agency, still exists in that there is a pandemic of the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

The following facts substantiate such a finding:

- Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a potentially severe acute respiratory infection caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). The virus was first identified as the cause of an outbreak of pneumonia of unknown cause in Wuhan City, Hubei Province, China, in December 2019; and
- On March 9, 2020, Governor J.B. Pritzker declared all counties in the State of Illinois as a disaster area which continues to remain in effect; and
- On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization characterized the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic; and
- On March 11, 2020, McHenry County Board Chair Jack D. Franks proclaimed that a disaster emergency exists for the County of McHenry which continues to remain in effect; and
- Following these actions, President John C. Schmitt issued a Proclamation of Local Disaster Emergency for the Village of Algonquin on March 17, 2020 which continues to remain in effect; and
- Governor Pritzker has issued 15 Executive Orders relating to COVID-19, including Executive Order 2020-10 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 8) effective through April 7, 2020 issuing a stay at home order for state residents, restricting the operations of non-essential businesses, and mandating that all public and private gatherings in the State of Illinois of ten people or more are prohibited.

The nature of the emergency is to control the current outbreak of the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

During the existence of the Local State of Emergency, the President shall execute such authority as provided under the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, and Chapter 8, Emergency Services and Disaster Agency of the Village of Algonquin Municipal Code.

This Declaration of Local State of Emergency shall be filed with the Village Clerk as soon as practicable.

I, John C. Schmitt, whose name is signed to this instrument, being first duly sworn, signed and executed the instrument as the Declaration of Local State of Emergency, and that I signed willingly, and that I executed it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed.
